## **COMPETITION CATEGORIES:**

### **1- Art Project**

Ideas inspired by scientific courses, integrate your art into science—for example, Architectural design, 3D models, sketches, hand-drawn or digital illustrations, etc.

### **2- Digital Project**

Digital dentistry design with higher technical quality

### **3- Poster Presentation**

Display your research findings visually and discuss them with judges

### **4- Oral Presentation**

Present your research idea in a structured oral presentation



# SUBMISSION REQUIREMENTS

Students are required to submit the following components:

## 1. ABSTRACT

- A concise abstract (maximum 300 words) summarizing the research idea and concept, clearly integrating both the artistic and digital aspects of the project.
- The abstract should outline the aim, scientific relevance to dentistry, methodology/approach, and expected outcome.

**After abstract review, participants will be assigned faculty supervisors to further develop and refine their ideas.**

## 2. POSTER PRESENTATION

- Students selecting the poster format must submit:
- Digital poster draft in PDF format.
- Printed poster with the following specifications:
  1. Size: 33.1 × 46.8 inches (84.1 × 118.9 cm)
  2. Format: A0, portrait orientation
- Posters must be visually clear, scientifically accurate, and professionally designed.

## 3. ORAL PRESENTATION

Students selecting the oral presentation must submit:

- A PowerPoint presentation consisting of no more than (7) slides.
- Slides should be concise, visually engaging, and scientifically sound.
