About the Faculty of Law:

The Faculty of Law at Zarqa University was established with the university's inception in 1994. It awards a bachelor's degree in law. The faculty holds a scientific conference whenever necessary and a scientific day is organized every year.

The faculty contributes to the achievement of its scientific and social mission and constitutes a tributary for the various sectors at the national and regional levels with scientifically and practically qualified human cadres that contribute to construction and development.

Faculty Vision:

Striving to achieve the highest standards of quality and academic accreditation in education, rehabilitation and scientific research for both faculty members and students, serving the local community, combining authenticity and modernity, preserving social and legal values and applying the spirit of legal texts, upgrading the legal and judicial reality through scientific research and preparing students who are scientifically, intellectually and behaviorally qualified to perform their active role in society.

Faculty Mission:

Preparing graduates who are scientifically and theoretically qualified in line with the needs of the local community and the region, armed with theoretical legal knowledge in various branches of law as well as the ability to deal with judicial applications and providing graduates with basic knowledge and means of scientific research and the use of legal knowledge sources that facilitate them to complete their studies and research, as well as providing graduates with the skills necessary to qualify them in communication with others and team spirit with strong beliefs that serve their society with sincerity and Truthfulness.

Faculty Departments and Specializations

The Faculty is currently composed of one department that awards a Bachelor of Laws and a Master of Laws degree. Its program accredits the program approved by the Commission for Accreditation of Higher Education Institutions and its Quality Assurance.

The language of teaching in the Faculty is Arabic, and the Faculty is concerned in teaching legal terminology in English, as it is one of the influential languages in dealing with jurisprudence of legal studies.

Faculty Equipment:

The Faculty has allocated teaching rooms equipped with the latest educational aids (projectors, screens, and computers), and an air-conditioned courtroom has been equipped, containing equipment similar to modern courtrooms, in addition to equipment related to e-learning.

Conferences and Scientific Days:

The Faculty has held several local and international conferences, and also holds annual scientific days at the level of Jordanian universities, in which various effective topics are presented, which have scientific and practical importance in the societal reality.

Cooperation Agreements:

The Faculty has cooperation agreements with many prestigious Arab and foreign universities, such as: University of Baghdad, University of Mosul, Gulf universities, and with many organizations, such as the European Organization - Tempus, in order to enhance frameworks of joint cooperation and scientific and cultural exchange.

Faculty Goals:

The Faculty of Law seeks to achieve the following goals:

1. Providing opportunities for higher education and specialization in the field of rights and judicial work, and contributing to providing society with specialists and experts in those fields.
2. Developing knowledge by doing and encouraging scientific research, whether by faculty members or students, and employing it in solving problems and development issues.
3. Building the student's personality in its various dimensions in accordance with the Arab and Islamic values system, with an emphasis on the methodology of scientific thinking, initiative, a sense of responsibility and then work and public service, and strengthening the student's belonging to his/ her country and nation to be a good and reconciled individual at the same time.
4. Opening postgraduate programs in various legal disciplines, in line with the needs of the local and regional labor market.
5. Paying attention to the Arabic language in teaching and scientific research and working on transferring knowledge from its various sources into the Arabic language.
6. Strengthening scientific ties with the corresponding faculties of law in local, Arab, Islamic and international universities and exchanging experiences with them.
7. Organizing specialized scientific conferences and seminars that raise the issue of solving a specific problem or several problems related to legal and judicial development issues.
8. Seeking to attract faculty members with distinguished scientific expertise and competence.
9. Enable the student to do the work related to his specialization.
10. Serving the community and contributing to its development and solving its problems through training courses for workers in various judicial institutions and providing expertise and specialized advice in practical aspects.

Projects:

The study plan of the Faculty of Law includes compulsory specialization courses. These courses help the student to carry out projects and research in the judicial and legal fields, and enable him to analyze judicial decisions.

Scientific Research and Community Service:

The university works to provide the necessary financial support, as well as equipment, to develop knowledge by carrying out scientific research, whether by faculty members or students, and employing it in solving development problems and issues.

Research Teams:

The Faculty promotes cooperation between faculty members and Faculty students, to conduct many researches, specialized scientific seminars, and seminars that discuss solving a specific problem, or several problems related to legal and judicial development issues, as well as strengthening cooperation with research and scientific centers inside and outside Jordan.

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
